## GMAT/GRE Waiver Policy\*



Applicants who meet the following criteria are eligible for the waiver:

- Earned a BBA from an AACSB-accredited school
- Minimum GPA of 3.50 in all upper-division (300-level or higher) coursework
- Attend writing workshop (read information below)
- Meet Math requirements (outlined below)

Applicants will request the GMAT/GRE waiver by checking the appropriate box on the Application for Graduate Admission. Apply online here: <https://online.mgt.unm.edu/mba/>.

After an applicant's MBA application has been processed and the applicant has been granted the GMAT/GRE waiver, specific information about the writing workshop and MGMT 500 will be included in the Admission Status email.

### Writing Workshop Information

**ALL** applicants granted a waiver are required to attend the writing workshop held prior to the start of the semester. There is **no** charge for this three hour workshop. Information on registration and dates of these workshops will be included in the Admission Status email.

Applicants who received their BBA **over 5 years ago** will be required to take MGMT 500.

### Math Requirement Information

Applicants who received their BBA **within the past five (5) years**, will be evaluated for enrollment in MGMT 500 based on the following:

- Applicants receiving a 3.0 or better in either MATH 162 or 180 or an equivalent calculus class from another college do **not** need to take MGMT 500.
- Applicants receiving a 3.0 or better in a calculus class that is a higher level than MATH 180 or its equivalent do **not** need to take MGMT 500 even if they received less than a 3.0 in MATH 180 or its equivalent.
- Applicants who have below a 3.0 in MATH 180 or its equivalent **will** need to take MGMT 500.
